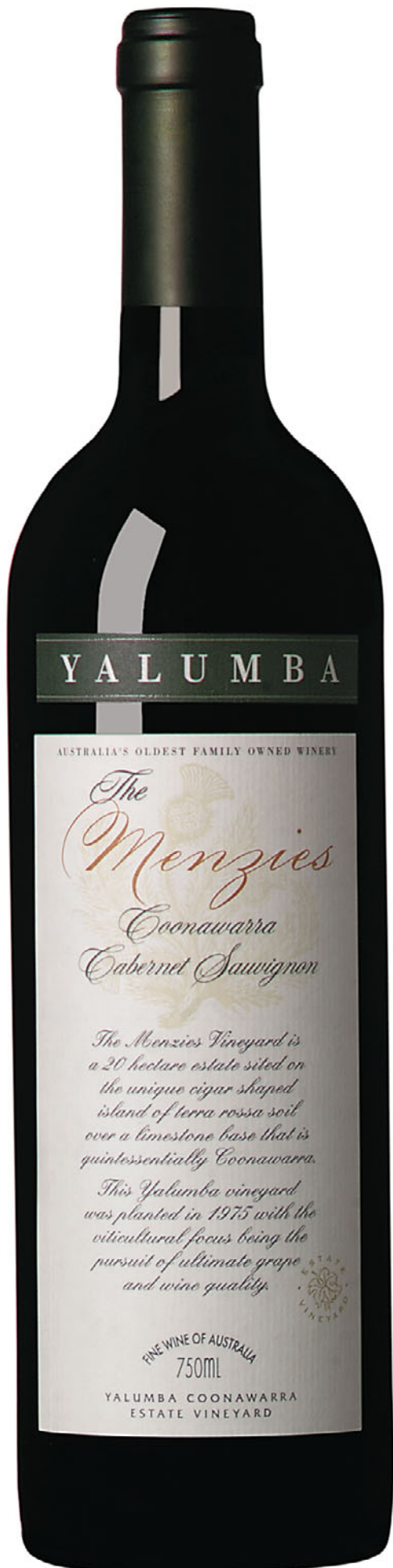


2003 Limestone Coast Wine Show



Gold for Yalumba The Menzies Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon

Yalumba The Menzies Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2000 was awarded a Gold Medal (Class 23, Dry Red, Cabernet Sauvignon) at the 2003 Limestone Coast Wine Show. July 2004 will see the release of this award winning wine, which has now been awarded 2 Gold and 4 Silver Medals.

Deep crimson red in colour, Yalumba The Menzies Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2000 offers an intense, complex nose with aromas of cassis and soy and a tangy sea spray note. The palate is medium bodied and well balanced with rich berry fruits and delicious hints of chocolate, leading into a lengthy velvet finish.

This is an outstanding result for The Menzies in its home show, especially considering the tough competition the wine came up against in its class – Cabernet Sauvignon – and the quality of the 2000 vintage. The Gold was awarded at the perfect time, prior to the wine's release in July 2004.
